

REPORT ON Provision of Furniture to Government Girls Middle School

Project Background

This project intends to provide education services to all girls from the area for the period of one year initially then this school will be handed over to government’s education department. So Muslim Aid is responsible for successful running of this girls middle school for 12 month from April 2012 to March 2013 jointly with major support from Muslim Aid UK and support of furniture from Qidwai Welfare projects. There was no facility available in the area for girls to receive further education of middle schooling after completing their primary education. The Muslim Aid teams working in the area under different projects involving targeted communities, forwarded need for girls middle school from communities. Muslim Aid realized the need which was on genuine grounds, so it mobilized its resources to address this very important need of the area.

So Muslim Aid is focusing to contribute in easily access to middle education for all girls from village Kotla Daha, providing quality education through capacity building of teaching staff and ensuring availability of necessary facilities & materials and increasing girls enrolment rates at middle level at village level. All project team consisting on Head Teacher, three middle teachers, one watchman, and one peon cum cleaner been hired and had joined their duties since first week of May 2012.

All required furniture is handed over to school funded by Qidwai Welfare projects and currently is under use of students and staff. The detail of furniture provided to this Girls Middle School is as under:
