Climate From the Arabian Sea, to the high mountain of the north, Pakistan's weather varies widely.

In general terms (*south and east of the mountains*) the country is hot and dry in the summer months, with very little rain. Along the southern coastal areas humidity is very high.

In the northern and western mountains, summers are much cooler, and winter brings heavy snow. Throughout the Hindu Kush and the rugged peaks of the far north, Arctic-like conditions in winter are the norm.

The heaviest rain (*central and south*), falls July through September, while winters do bring some light rain.

In the central Punjab region, May - July are the hottest months, with daily high temps averaging near 90° f. High temps above 100° f. are common. Winter lows seldom fall below 40° f.

The coastal areas enjoy milder, more consistent temperatures, with daily highs averaging near 85° f., and winter lows near 55° f.

LOCATION PROFILE

Kotli, the District Headquarter, is at a distance of 141 kilometers from Rawalpindi/ Islamabad via Sensa, Holar and Kahuta. It is linked with Mirpur by two metallic roads, one via Rajdhani (90 Kilometers) and the other via Charhoi. It is also directly linked with Rawalakot via Tarkhal (82 Kilometers). The area now comprising district Kotli was a sub-division of Mirpur district up to the year 1975. District Kotli is a hilly area rising gradually towards the high mountains of Poonch district. Its climate is more moderate than that of Mirpur due to the sub- mountainous topography.

It is also called "Madina-tu-Masajid" (City of Mosques). Nikyal is the tehsil of Kotli.

Nikyal was a part of tehsil Mahnder before independence, It Is located at a distance of 40 kilometres from Kotli and 181 kilometers from Islamabad Due to high altitude (1524 meters) Fatehpur is comparatively a cold place then the rest of the district.
